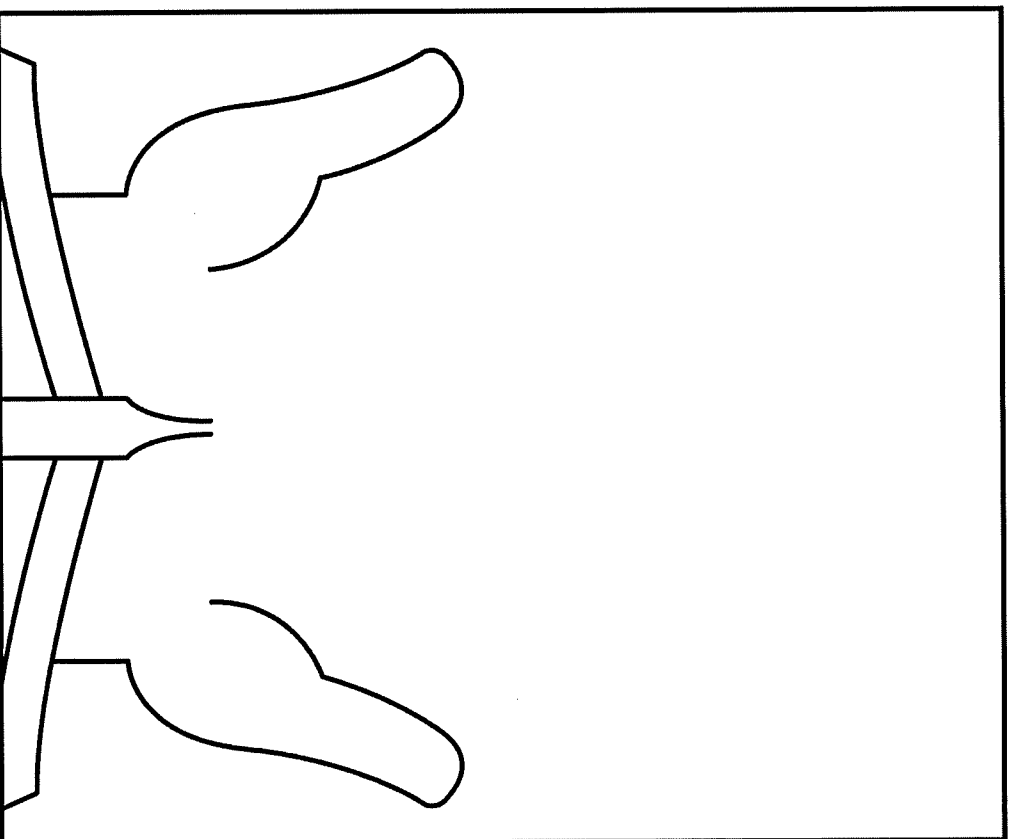
# DRAW IT

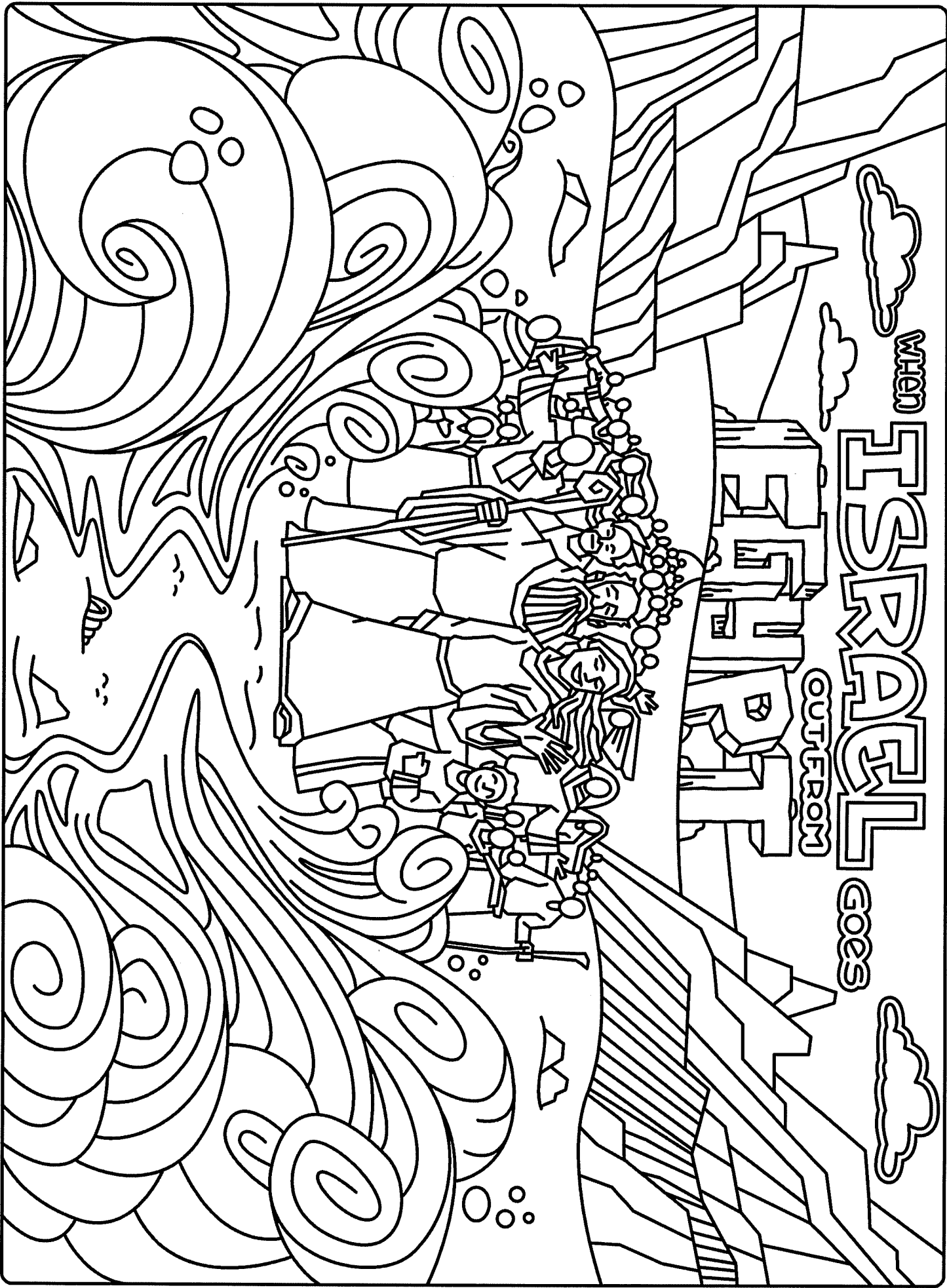
